'All the World is a Stage' is a South West England girl event for all sections, to celebrate World Thinking Day.

Location: WISE Campus, New Road, Stoke Gifford, Bristol, BS34 8LP

Date: Saturday 25th February 2012

Times: 10.00am - 5.15pm. Registration from 9.30am.

Cost: £15 per girl ticket. Leaders no charge

Activities

'All the World is a Stage' will have a performing arts theme. The day will be an exciting mix of dance, drama, music and theatre workshops as well as craft activities and a 'chill out' zone. The event will conclude with a promise renewal and a finale showcasing some of the activities from the workshops.

There will be activities appropriate for girls of all ages (5-17 years) and units will be able to choose workshops in advance. You will receive information on this when your places are confirmed.

Why not use the event to inspire the girls to start on the Region's latest resource 'A Night at the Theatre?'

Leaders

On this occasion there is no charge for leaders as they will be non-participant. The role of the leader is to supervise and support the girls during the workshops, in the 'chill out' zone and around the college. Please ensure that the correct adult:girl ratios are in place.

Travel

By road - The college is situated close to the M32, just north of Bristol. There is adequate on-site parking for cars, mini buses and some coaches. Parents may also drop off girls at the venue.

By rail- the college is within walking distance from Bristol Parkway and Filton Abbey Wood station. However it is strongly recommended that units use Parkway Station, as it is only a 15-20 minute walk from the college, along a **safe walking route**.

Units are responsible for organising their own transport.

Food

The girls will need to bring a packed lunch including drinks. A café, run by the college, will be available at the venue, selling hot and cold drinks and snacks.

What to Wear

Guide wear and suitable footwear to be worn. All activities will take place inside the building.

Shopping

The Region Shop will be on site selling a range of GGUK and South West Region merchandise and resources including the Night at the Theatre resource.

'All The World is a Stage' event badges will be available to purchase on the day at a cost of £1.

Application Process

- Places will be allocated on a first come first served basis. There is a maximum of 1000 girl places available.
- We can only accept postal applications.
- Payment for tickets, either by cheque or credit card, must be enclosed with the application form. It will not be possible to reserve places in advance.
- No applications will be accepted after **13th January 2012**, irrespective of numbers, to give adequate time to allocate places on workshops.
- Confirmation of bookings and any further communications regarding the event will be sent via email.
- Regular updates on the number of places booked will be posted on the Region website.

Booking Terms and Conditions

- Girlguiding South West England reserves the right to cancel this event if unforeseen circumstances arise. A full refund will be given on the cost of tickets to all participants.
- If a unit books places and is unable to attend on the day, for whatever reason, no refund will be given on the cost of tickets.
